# Visa exemption agreement between Myanmar and Brazil (21<sup>st</sup> September 2015)

The Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar and the Government of the Federative Republic of Brazil signed a visa exemption agreement for the holders of diplomatic and official passports. The agreement was signed by H.E. Thiri Pyanchi U Tun Nay Linn, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Myanmar to Brazil and H.E. Mr. Mauro Vieira, Minister of External Relations of Brazil, in Brasilia, Brazil on 27th August 2015. The exemption of visa will become effective on 26<sup>th</sup> September 2015.

According to the Agreement, citizens of either countries who are designated as members of the diplomatic or consular staff, and are in possession of valid diplomatic and official passports, shall not be required to obtain visas to enter the territory of the other country and shall be granted an appropriate visa for the period of their assignment, upon notification of the relevant Government with a period of thirty (30) days after their arrival.

Brazil became the 18<sup>th</sup> country in signing bilateral visa exemption agreement with Myanmar. Previously, Myanmar had signed the similar agreements with 17 countries: Bangladesh, Belarus, Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, China, India, Indonesia, Korea (DPRK), Korea (ROK), Laos, Malaysia, the Philippines, Russia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand and Viet Nam.
