ANNOUNCEMENT

on

Visa exemption agreement between Myanmar and Thailand

(19th August 2015)

The Government of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar and the Government of the Kingdom of Thailand signed a visa exemption agreement for citizens of both countries who hold ordinary passports and travel by air. The agreement was signed by H.E. U Wunna Maung Lwin, Union Minister for Foreign Affairs of Myanmar and H.E. General Tanasak Patimapagorn, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs of Thailand, in Chiang Mai, Thailand on 28 July 2015. The exemption of visa became effective on 11 August 2015.

According to the Agreement, citizens of either countries who are holding ordinary passports with at least six (6) months validity from the date of entry shall be exempted from any visa requirements for entry into, exit from and transit through the territory of the other country through international airports, and shall be entitled to stay in the territory of the other country for a period not exceeding fourteen (14) days from the date of entry.

Myanmar had signed the similar agreements with Brunei Darussalam, Cambodia, Laos, the Philippines and Viet Nam in accordance with the 2006 ASEAN Framework Agreement on Visa Exemption.
