PDF Terrorists Abduct Teachers Including the Principal of State Agricultural Institute-Dawei and also Kill a Deputy Staff Officer of the Township Agricultural Department



Deputy Staff Officer died in the aftermath of killing of PDFs

The so-called NUG terrorist group and its affiliates PDF terrorists holding arms arrived at the State Agricultural Institute (Dawei) located in Sakhan Gyi Village, Laung Lon Township of Tanintharyi Region on 20 July 2023. They then beat and tortured the teachers including the principal and students of the institute. The terrorists repeatedly threatened the teachers to join CDM and leave the Institute by 8:00 a.m. on 21 July. They then forcibly abducted the female principal, her 11-year-old son and five other teachers.

Similarly, PDF terrorists with motorbikes arrived at the house of U Thein Oo, deputy staff officer of the township agricultural department who was teaching as a substitute teacher at the Institute on 22 July. They then took him to a palm oil farm east of his house and shot him dead using small arms.

Myitnge-Ywarthagyi Freight Train Derails on Mandalay-Yangon Railroad due to the Acts of Unscrupulous People





No. (925) down-train of Myitnge-Ywarthagyi trip derailed at mile-post number (372/3-371/24) between Palate station and Singaing station on 23 July, detaching five fully-loaded coaches from 18 to 22 July. The derailment occurred for the segments of railway tracks were disconnected.

The root cause of the derailment was found out to be the act of unscrupulous people who removed 32 bolts/nuts and eight railroad clamps of the railway track on its both sides. The damaged segment of railway track was repaired promptly and the railway became functional in the morning of 24 July.
