• NDMC conducted Emergency Meeting

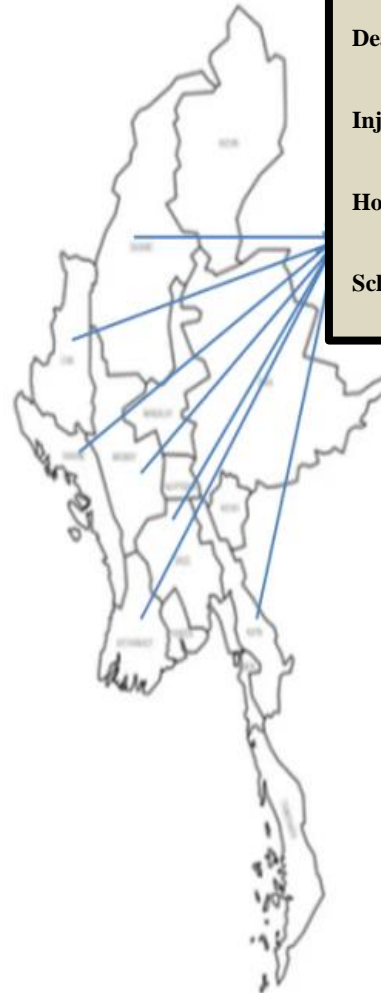

INTERNATIONAL RESPONSES



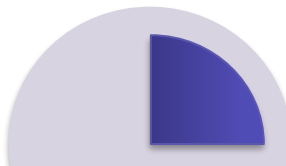
- ❖ Ministry of Health collaborated with WHO and UNICEF in planning rapid response teams and emergency medical teams, and stockpiling health supplies.
- ❖ AHA Centre assisted DMC in logistic matters; delivery of humanitarian assistance and assist (ASEAN-DRAT) team in conducting the damage and needs assessments.
- ❖ ICRC, IFRC and MRCS volunteers participated in evacuations, awareness campaigns and gathering of preliminary data. Continued to engage in rescue and resettlement process reaching 147,142 people.

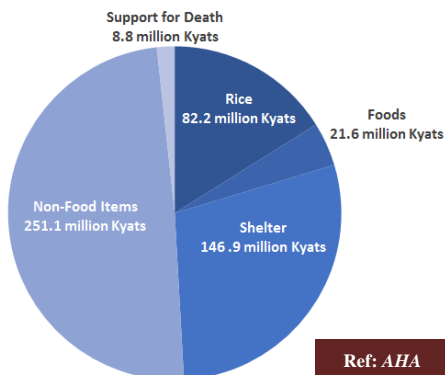

Recovery and Beneficiaries

Infrastructure and Services restoration:	Estimated numbers: Rakhine State (2.88 million population/ 357,000 households)
Agriculture and Fishery	1 million people [through cleanup and reclamation of well, ponds and farmland; provision of rice seeds and farming equipment]
Education	Half a million School children have access to school
Healthcare	Over 100,000 Beneficiaries received health care from Rapid Response Medical teams, Specialist teams, Defense Services Medical Teams and Heal facilities.
Jobs	4,512 Jobs were created in Electricity sector: Construction/ cleaning/ restoration
Emergency Food Supplies	163,841-194,288 people [Rakhine] 2,171-2,575 people [Chin]
Cash Assistance	152 Families in Rakhine State received cash assistance in the first two weeks
